- Content : Electromagnetic fields comprise a wide range of frequencies, from low frequencies with wavelengths that are many meters long (some radio frequencies) to the shortest frequencies like x-rays or gamma rays.
- In the electro-medicine field, radio frequencies (RF) are used that fluctuate between 0.45 and 0.60 MHz, which have proven to be safe when applied to the human body. Proof of the previously stated fact is that all of the diathermy devices used in surgery work within the margin mentioned above. The effects that RF currents have are related to their frequency, power and polarization. The frequencies that are closest to the resonance of the human body lead to an increased energetic absorption and, therefore, to an increased thermal effect. The debut of Radiofrequency-based electro physical device has been introduced into the world of Physical Therapy for almost two decade. The frequency of used has exceeded 100,000 times worldwide. Today the extended number of approved indication for treatments include Traumatic injury, Joint injuries, Rheumatic diseases, Sports physical therapy, Pelvic floor treatments, Physio aesthetic treatment.
